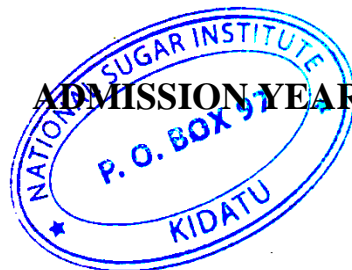

RE: **STUDENT'S JOINING INSTRUCTIONS**

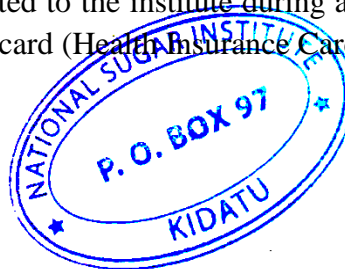
- 1.0 I am glad to inform you that you have been selected to join with National **Sugar Institute** (NSI), in a special programme called **ORDINARY DIPLOMA IN SUGAR PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY** (3 YEARS). Therefore you will start from Basic Technician Certificate – NTA level 4 up to Ordinary diploma NTA Level 6.
- 2.0 This programme will starts on **14th October 2024**; you are required to report to the Institute as from **14th to 18th October 2024** ready for registration and other compulsory formalities.
- 3.0 Your chance shall immediately be given to somebody else if a week (7 days) elapses without reporting to the Institute.
- 4.0 Your registration to the Institute is subject to you being physically fit. You are required to attach the filled medical examination form by a qualified **Government Medical Officer**.
- 5.0 On your arrival to the institute, you will be required to report to the Institutes' students admission office and present the following documents for formal registration;
 - [i] Original National Examination Council Certificate / Result slip certificate (CSEE).
 - [ii] A medical examination form filled by Medical Officer
 - [iii] Three colored (3) stamp size photographs
 - [iv] Bank deposit slip.
 - [v] A slip of acceptance dully filled to indicate your acceptance to join with this programme and **pay all Contributions** as stipulated in this joining instruction letter.

NOTE:

Please make sure that, your certificates are valid and original (officially authorized to you). Lawful action against you shall immediately be taken/exercised in case of any cheating or forgery.

6.0 **NIDA NUMBER / NIDA IDENTITY CARD**

All selected students above 18 years old must be registered to the National Identification Authority (NIDA). The card or NIDA number **MUST** be submitted to the institute during arrival. The NIDA number/cards will be used for subscription with NHIF card (Health Insurance Card).

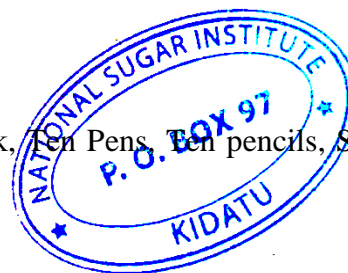

14 **DISCIPLINE**

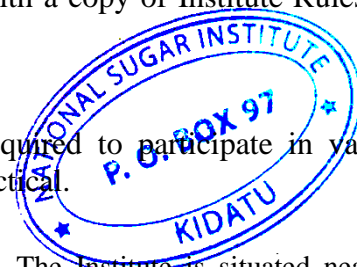

The National Sugar Institute is in Morogoro Region, Kilosa District. The Institute is situated near the Kilombero Sugar Company (K II).



17 **MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION**

The appropriate “Bus” you can take when you are coming to National Sugar Institute from **Dar es Salaam** is either “**KIDINILO BUS**’ or “**ALSAEDY**”. From Morogoro Municipal, you may travel by **Oman Mini Bus, or Master J Minibus**. From **Iringa**, the appropriate bus is **Nani Kaona Mini Bus**, from **Arusha** and **Kilimanjaro** the best travel can be by **Laviha and, HC Buses**. From **Mbeya and Njombe regions you can travel by Another G bus**. Feel free to tell the bus conductor that you are going to **CHUO CHA SUKARI CHA TAIFA – KIDATU** and you are dropping at **STAND YA MBUZI** Bus station. From Stand ya Mbuzi you may take Bodaboda for the cost of not more than 2,000/= up to **Chuo Cha Sukari cha Taifa**.

18 **POSTAL, BANK SERVICES AND SHOPPING**

Postal and Banks (NMB & CRDB) services are available within a walking distance from the Institute. Shopping can be made within the Institute premises or at small town of Ruaha, which is within the vicinity.

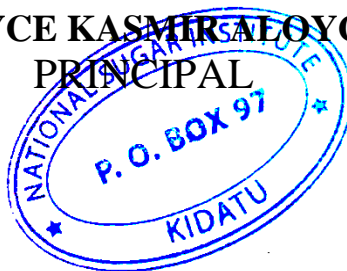

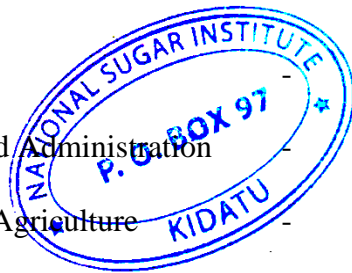
